

NEISA:

The NEISA draft committee was ask to look at two items for the second year of the NEISA Interconference Draft. The first was to look at events where there is more than one host and see if that can be sorted out for the draft. The second was to look at when the host needed to select their own event relative to the number of berths allocated to NEISA.

The NEISA Draft Committee explored these two questions and have come up with the following proposals:

Proposal 1:

We propose that host teams must select their own event after 8 other teams chosen their event.

We realize the number of berth allocations may change for these NEISA events. We would propose that the hosts need to select at the minimum number of NEISA berths at these events.

Proposal 2:

Enforce the current rule about host berths:

To be eligible to receive a host berth at a NEISA intersectional, a team must fulfill one of the following requirements:

- i.)Provide a fleet of 18 or more boats.
- ii.)Provide a fleet equal to the number of teams at the event.
- iii.)Provide 6 or more sail-boats AND provide the entire race committee for a race course for both days of the event.
