Owen Trophy:

For the teams that are considered a part of the Old Guard in NEISA (Brown, Coast Guard, Dartmouth, Harvard, MIT, Williams, and Yale), once two other teams select this event, the members of the Old Guard will have the option to select the event as a host pick. If they pass, their host pick goes away. This allows these teams to have the first refusal for this event.

Host berths in the draft process:

For team race regattas, the host will select after five other teams have selected the event. (The one exemption to this is the Rudkin Team Race where the host will have to select after 4 other teams pick this event.)

For fleet race regattas, the host will have to pick after 9 other teams have selected their event. 10 is the average number of NE berths for these fleet race events. The exceptions to this rule are the Danmark, Moody, and Oberg where there are fewer than 10 NE berths at these events. For these events, the host will have to pick these events when there is one more berth remaining at the event. (Danmark host will select after 8 other teams picked the event, Oberg host will select after 6 other teams, and Moody host will select after 6 other teams select this event.)

Drafting Second Teams:

We have discussed a supplemental draft in the fall and the spring for second teams at events where second teams are allowed. We have not fully fleshed out the details of this plan to come forth with a proposal.
